#### 1. ENROLLMENT

#### REQUIRED DOCUMENTS FOR REGISTRATION:

- a) Passport
- b) Original hard copy of High School Diploma or equivalent Certificate (translated in English or Turkish)
- c) Transcript of Records (translated in English or Turkish)
- d) Denklik\*- Turkish High-school Equivalence Certificate of High School diploma authorized by Turkish Education Council. A letter certifying that your High School Diploma is equal to a Turkish High School Diploma.

\*Denklik may be issued by the Turkish Consulate in your country or the National Education Directorates in Istanbul.

Or you may apply for it Online through the official website https://edenklik.meb.gov.tr

In order to apply for this letter in Istanbul, you should submit your original and translated copy of high school diploma/ transcript showing all the courses you have taken in High School, grades and credit hours, copy of BAU acceptance letter, and a copy of Passport.( Students under the age of 18 are required to obtain notarized consent letter of parents or legal guardian.)

- e) Copy of Acceptance letter
- f) 2 photograph (ID size)
- g) Copy of deposit payment receipt (or first semester payment receipt if available)
- h) TOEFL IBT/Home-Edition 72/ (for English Language Teaching min. IBT 79), PTE academic 55, CAE C certificate (if any)



#### 2. PAYMENT

All full-time international students must show a receipt for their first semester tuition payment to complete registration. Undergraduate students may pay yearly fee in two installments. Graduate students may pay for their program in three installments (first 3 semesters).

Registration is completed after submitting a bank receipt (for payments in cash) or BAU financial Office receipt (for payments in credit card) to the International Office.

After registration, students will be provided with personal information, & student ID number. Personal login/ Passcode will also be provided after registration is done, and the student will be scheduled for the BAU profiency exam if required\*

#### \* BAU ENGLISH PROFICIENCY EXAM

Bahçeşehir University is an English medium university and all undergraduate students are either required to complete the English Preparatory Program successfully or to be exempt from the Preparatory Program. Students with no prior or required knowledge of English TOEFL IBT/Home-Edition 72/ (for English Language Teaching min. IBT 79), PTE academic 55, CAE C certificate (if any) will need to attend BAU English proficiency exam.

Following proficiency exam scores are adequate for Bachelors' Degree programs;

**TOEFL:** min. IBT 72 (for English Language Teaching min. IBT 79)

YDS / e-YDS / YÖKDİL: min. 60 (for English Language Teaching min. 80)

Pearson PTE Academic: min. 55 (for English Language Teaching min. 78)

CAE: min. C (for English Language Teaching min. A)

Bahçeşehir University Proficiency Exam: min. 60 (for English Language Teaching min. 80)

For Programs taught in Turkish Language TOMER/TURKMER B2 Certificate

Result of your English Proficiency Exam will be announced on October 9th, 2020 Friday in the "News and Announcement" on the Web page of the School of Foreign Languages.

Admitted students who do not demonstrate sufficient mastery of English in each test will be referred to the BAU English Preparatory School for preliminary language instruction according to their results of examination. Prepschool classes start on **October 12th, 2020** 

Note: Only registered students are allowed to attend BAU English exam

Students who have got required English Proficiency tests scores or passed BAU Prof. exam will be placed in freshman classes automatically after registration.

#### 3. RESIDENCE PERMIT

Please visit the International office so we could assist you with the following Residence Permit application process. Foreign students are required to have student visa except nationalities exempted from visa to enter Turkey for travels up to 30-90 days. All other types of visas or legal entrance procedures will be accepted by BAU for registration as well.

BAU requires all international students at the Istanbul campuses to obtain residence permits from the Turkish government. In order to have application documents submitted / approved in a proper and faster way, BAU International office will assist you through the application process and deliver your files to Directorate General of Migration Management. It is the Student's responsibility to apply and follow the application process, & International Office can not be held responsible if the student fails to apply on time or properly. It is highly recommended to visit BAU International Office in order to apply for residence permit properly.

Turkey considers students to have "applied" for their **Residence Permit after they** apply for the Appointment Application Form at the International Office.



Prepare your documents before arriving to the International Office, here is a checklist of all the documents you need for the Residence Permit Appointment Application Process:

- a. Passport.
- b. Photocopy of passport ID page and the pages with the student visa and entry stamps. (Only If you need visa to enter Turkey.)
- c. Student certificate (in Turkish Obtained from the SAP/Student Affairs Office).
  - d. Health Insurance.
  - e. 4 passport-sized photographs
- f. Receipt for application fee. (Ziraat Bank or Tax Offices) Obtained after finishing the Application.
  - g. Tax number from tax office.
  - h. Active Phone Number in Turkey.
  - i. If you are under 18: Consent Letter & Birth Certificate.

## How To Get To The Main Gampus.


#### **Besiktas Campus (Main Campus)**

#### From ISTANBUL Airport

- TaxiCab: Taxis to Beşiktaş cost about 150 Turkish Lira (TL) or \$25. The trip takes 45-60minutes, depending on traffic.
- Motorcoach: HAVAIST runs regular shuttles between the ISTANBUL airport and Beşiktaş where the
  university campus is located <a href="https://hava.ist/en">https://hava.ist/en</a> (You could make payment online) or with
  ISTANBULKART (METRO CARD) The trip costs 18 TL (\$3), with ISTANBULKART (METRO CARD)
- Public Transit: Travel to the main campus from ISTANBUL airport is possible on public transit. However, it is not recommended for inexperienced travellers. Take H-2 bus line to the mecidiyeköy and from mecidiyeköy take 30 A bus to Beşiktaş where the main campus is located. The total trip cost is 5.5 TL(\$1). The fare is only payable with ISTANBUL KART (METRO CARD) Whic can be obtained from public transport stations



#### From Sabiha Gökçen International Airport:

Sabiha Gökçen International Airport is farther from the campus, on the far side of the Asian neighborhoods across the Bosphorus. Available transportation is:

- Taxicab: Approximately 160 TL (\$25 USD). The trip takes between 40 and 90 minutes.
- Motorcoach: HAVATAIST or HAVABUS runs shuttles from this airport to Taksim. 15 TL (\$2 USD), 60-90 minutes, plus a short taxi ride from Taksim to the campus. https://hava.ist/en (You could make payment online) or with ISTANBULKART (METRO CARD
- http://www.havabus.com/ only with ISTANBUL KART (METRO CARD)
  - Public Transit from this airport is not recommended for inexperienced travelers.





Please note: Accommodation, meals, transportation, school supplies etc. are not included in tuition fee. Students themselves are responsible for arranging and paying their accommodation and other personal expenses. The information below will help you to review some options popular among our students.

As a city university BAU campus includes only academic and administrative facilities and offers accommodation outside the campus. REPUBLIKA Academic Aparts is also located in the city center (about 10–20 min by bus or 25 min walking distance).






Choose Student Certificate and the language. (Choose it in Turkish, for the residence permit application and/or Student bus card).
